RESOLUTION LAUDING AND COMMENDING FILIPINO JIU-JITSU ATHLETE MYRON MYLES MANGUBAT FOR ACHIEVING A BRONZE MEDAL AT THE 2023 SOUTHEAST ASIAN GAMES HELD AT PHNOM PENH, CAMBODIA ON MAY 4 TO 7, 2023

WHEREAS, the City Council of Manila has consistently given recognition and commendation to exemplary Filipino athletes through their relentless pursuit of sports excellence, and bringing honor and pride to both the city and the country by winning accolades in international competitions;

WHEREAS, Myron Myles Mangubat, 33 years of age, has been competing at the Jiu-Jitsu International Federation (JJIF) since 2019, ranking 14 overalls in the Men's Ne-Waza Gi, 62kg category after previously competing in the 69kg category;

WHEREAS, Mangubat claimed the bronze medal after winning against Amirul Syafig bin Shah Eran of Singapore and Andrew Than of Thailand;

WHEREAS, Mangubat started training in competitive Jiu-Jitsu in 2009 under Deftac RT Jiu-Jitsu or Deftac Pilipinas. He is currently a part of the Carpe Diem Manila team;

WHEREAS, Mangubat lived in Tondo, Manila, in the First District, and studied at the St. Joseph High School for his secondary education and later studied at the Far Eastern University until he first started competing internationally in 2011;

WHEREAS, Mangubat was also momentarily engaged with Mixed Martial Arts (MMA) before focusing completely on Jiu-Jitsu;

WHEREAS, Mangubat is set to compete at the Jiu-Jitsu 2023 World Championship on 14 July 2023 at Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia along with other Filipino athletes;


WHEREAS, Mr. Mangubat is one of many exemplary Filipino athletes have the natural talents, the skills and stamina to fight for the country;
