WHEREAS, the CHAMBER OF CUSTOMS BROKERS, INCORPORATED, with office address at Manila Executive Regency, 1200 J. Bocobo Street, Ermita, Manila, a duly registered organization with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), is seeking accreditation as a registered Non-Governmental Organization (NGO);

WHEREAS, the same organization submitted the accomplished requisites and supporting documents for purposes of accreditation;


