**RESOLUTION** EXPRESSING THE SUPPORT OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF MANILA FOR THE PASSAGE OF SENATE BILL NO. 2356, INTRODUCED BY SENATOR RAMON "BONG" REVILLA, JR., WHICH SEEKS TO PROVIDE AN ADDITIONAL TWELVE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP. 12,000.000) INCREASE IN THE MINIMUM PAY OF EMPLOYEES AND WORKERS IN THE PUBLIC SECTOR NATIONWIDE

WHEREAS, Section 18, Article II of the 1987 Constitution affirms labor as a primary social economic force and mandates the State to protect the rights and promote the welfare of workers;

WHEREAS, the current state of the minimum pay in the public sector is not reflective of the current economic realities, which have seen the erosion of the real value of salaries due to inflation and other factors;

WHEREAS, the proposed Senate Bill No. 2356, also known as "The Additional P12,000 Increase in the Minimum Pay Act of 2023", seeks to enhance the living conditions of ordinary Filipinos by providing a decent and humane standard of living and improved quality of life, particularly for workers in the public sectors;


WHEREAS, this measure aligns with the constitutional mandate to guarantee workers a living wage and to promote social justice through policies ensuring the well-being and economic security of all members of the community: NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of Manila to express, as it hereby expresses support for the passage of Senate Bill No. 2356, introduced by Senator Ramon "Bong" Revilla, Jr., which seeks to provide an additional Twelve Thousand Pesos (PhP. 12,000.000) increase in the minimum pay of employees and workers in the public sector nationwide; and be it FURTHER

RESOLVED, that the City Council of Manila urges each district representatives of the city to actively support and advocate for the passage of this bill in the pursuit of uplifting the economic condition of public sector employees in the city and across the nation; and be it FINALLY

RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished the Office of Senator Ramon "Bong" Revilla, Jr.
