

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING CALIFORNIA STREET, FROM TAFT AVENUE TO DART STREET, AS "JOSEFA LLANES ESCODA STREET".

WHEREAS, Josefa Llanes Escoda, late president of the National Federation of Women's Clubs, typifies the Filipino clubwoman at her best;

WHEREAS, in peace she was a devoted wife and mother and a model social worker; in war, she was an outstanding social worker;

WHEREAS, no roll of our national heroes would be complete without the name of Josefa Llanes Escoda, whose wartime deeds, heroic sacrifices and martyrdom are enshrined in the heart of every Filipino; and

WHEREAS, an insignificant memorial to perpetuate the name and memory of this great woman could be had by renaming one of the streets of Manila after her. For this purpose, California Street, From Taft Avenue up to Dart Street, should be renamed as "Josefa Llanes Escoda Street": Now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. California Street, from Taft Avenue up to Dart Street, is hereby renamed "Josefa Llanes Escoda Street".


SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
