

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE PROPOSED CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL, WHICH WILL BE CONSTRUCTED ON HARRISON PARK, "ARSENIO D. LACSON MEMORIAL HOSPITAL".

WHEREAS, the late Mayor Arsenio D. Lacson, during his lifetime, was always mindful of the interest and welfare of the people of Manila, more particularly of the sick and the unfortunate;

WHEREAS, there is no better proof of his concern for the sick than his monumental project for a city general hospital;

WHEREAS, all the requisites for the realization of this project have already been met and construction will soon start;

WHEREAS, it is both timely and necessary to adopt a name for the hospital and there would never be a more fitting tribute in perpetuating the memory of the man who was its chief architect than by naming this institution in his honor; Now, therefore

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. The proposed City General Hospital, which will be constructed on Harrison Park, is hereby named "ARSENIO D. LACSON MEMORIAL HOSPITAL".

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
