AN ORDINANCE RENAMING ISAAC PERAL STREET, FROM DEWEY BOULEVARD TO CAMMUNICO STREET TO "UNITED NATIONS AVENUE".

RHERRAS, the United Nations, the last remaining hope of mankind for a lasting world peace, will celebrate its 17th enniversary on October 24, 1962;

WHEREAS, although it is an admitted fect that the United Mations has achieved so much for the welfare of mankind; particularly with respect to the proservation and maintenance of world peace, it is also true that there is a need for continued vigilance among its member countries of the wonderful things it has done, is doing and will continue to do for them;

WHEREAS, the different organs of the United Nations and its family of specialized agencies have, through the years, built in the Philippines on institution of knowledge and experience offering the highest guarantee of international understanding and cooperation;

WHEREAS, in the economic growth of our country, these different agencies of the United Nations have provided us with much needed assistance without which it would have been impossible for the Philippines to achieve what it is today;

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization (MNO) building where all the aforementioned United Nations asscinfized agencies are housed, is situated along Isaac Peral Street;

WHEREAS, as a fitting tribute to the United Nations and its specialized agencies for the splendid work they have performed for the Philippines in general and for the City of Manile, in particular, it is the consensus of the city government that Issac Peral Street should be named "United Nations Avenue"; " Now, there-

Be it ordained by the Municipal Board of the City of Manila, that:

SECTION 1. Issac Persi Street, from Dewey Boulevard to Cumoning Street, is hereby renamed "United Nations Avenue".

SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
