RESOLUTION COMMEMORATING AND CELEBRATING "LINGGO NG KALAYAAN", ALSO KNOWN AS INDEPENDENCE WEEK FROM JUNE 6 TO 12 EVERY YEAR BASED ON THE DECLARATION OF PHILIPPINE INDEPENDENCE, STRENGTHENING NATIONALISM AND INSTILLING THE VALUE OF FREEDOM AND DEMOCRACY IN THE CITY OF MANILA

WHEREAS, the first constitutional democracy in Asia was established on June 12, 1898 with the signing of the Philippine Declaration of Independence from Spain, which occurred one hundred twenty-six (126) years ago this year, a historic milestone that represents the bravery, tenacity and solidarity of the Filipino people;

WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 914, s. 1992, issued by former President Corazon C. Aquino, designated the period of June 6 to 12 of each year as "Linggo ng Kalayaan", also known as Independence Week week-long celebration preceding the Philippines' Independence Day;

WHEREAS, "Linggo ng Kalayaan" is a celebration that commemorates the country's declaration of independence from Spanish colonial rule on June 12, 1898. It serves as a poignant reminder of our ancestors' struggles and sacrifices in order to secure our freedom;

WHEREAS, it is more than just commemorating a historical event, it is also a reminder to Filipinos to be proud of their heritage and culture. It inspires us to reflect on the achievements and difficulties faced by our country and to strive as a single, cohesive people toward a better future;

WHEREAS, it also symbolizes the collective victory of the Filipino people against colonial oppression and is a monument to the nation's tenacity and enduring spirit;

WHEREAS, this week-long celebration also seeks to encourage all sectors to work together in the pursuit of projects and campaigns geared toward inspiring nationalism among Filipinos: NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of Manila to commemorate and celebrate, as it is hereby commemorates and celebrates "Linggo ng Kalayaan", also known as Independence Week from June 6 to 12 every year based on the Declaration of Philippine Independence, strengthening nationalism and instilling the value of freedom and democracy in the City of Manila; and be it FURTHER

RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to all government offices, departments, agencies and schools within the City of Manila.
