WHEREAS, Mayor Maria Sheilah “Honey” H. Lacuna-Pangan, MD, FPDS, and Mr. Charlie Duño, Director of the Department of Tourism, Culture and Arts of Manila (DTCAM), organized a successful civil and military parade on June 24, 2024 at Onyx Street, San Andres Bukid, Manila, showcasing Manila’s rich cultural heritage and history;


