**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 1 IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF EIGHTY-THREE MILLION SEVENTY-SIX THOUSAND PESOS (PHP. 83,076,000.00) AS ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION UNDER THE OTHER GENERAL SERVICES ACCOUNT OF THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR FOR FY 2024 ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 16 of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 7160 or the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991 provides that "every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare."


It further provides that "within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants.

Further, Section 17 of the LGC mandates "local government units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them. They shall also discharge the functions and responsibilities of national agencies and offices devolved to them pursuant to this Code. Local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities enumerated herein."

To fund priority programs and activities of the City, a supplemental budget may be enacted "when supported by funds actually available as certified by the local treasurer or by new revenue sources" (Section 321 of R.A. No. 7160) to ensure the implementation of the above-mentioned programs, activities and projects for the general welfare of the residents of the City of Manila.

Pursuant to the foregoing statutory provisions, the City Treasurer and the City Accountant have issued the Certificate of Availability of Funds as supporting document to the promulgation of this Supplemental Budget.

The City Council likewise approved Resolution No. 2, Series of 2024 of the Executive Committee of the City Development Council, entitled "A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AMENDMENT OF THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM AND ISSUANCE OF A SUPPLEMENTAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM FOR FY 2024 FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PRIORITY PROGRAMS, ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS FOR THE GENERAL WELFARE OF THE RESIDENTS OF MANILA".

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, in session assembled, *THAT*:

**SECTION 1. Appropriations.** – The FY 2024 Supplemental Budget of the City of Manila in the total amount of Eighty-Three Million Seventy-Six Thousand Pesos (PhP. 83,076,000.00) is hereby appropriated to fund the following programs, activities and projects of the City of Manila, to wit:



**SEC. 2. Separability Clause.** – If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

**SEC. 3. Effectivity Clause.** – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

On the motion presented by the Hon. Ernesto C. Isip, Jr., which was duly seconded, this Ordinance was finally approved for third and final reading by the City Council of Manila on July 23, 2024.




