RESOLUTION COMMEMORATING THE "NATIONAL DAY OF REMEMBRANCE FOR ROAD CRASH VICTIMS, SURVIVORS, AND THEIR FAMILIES", ANNUALLY OBSERVED EVERY THIRD SUNDAY OF NOVEMBER AND ENCOURAGING STRICT ADHERENCE TO ROAD SAFETY AND TRAFFIC RULES WITHIN THE CITY OF MANILA

WHEREAS, the "World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims" is an annual day of commemoration initiated by the United Nations (UN) pursuant to UN General Assembly Resolution 60/5 dated 1 December 2005 with the objective of improving global road safety, localized in the Philippines through Republic Act No. 11468;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4 of Republic Act No. 11468 also known as the "National Day of Remembrance for Road Crash Victims, Survivors, and their Families Act", the Department of Transportation (DOTr), in coordination with the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) shall ensure the implementation of the following programs and activities:

- Commemorative ceremonies, including wreath-laying offerings, candle light, vigil, solidarity march and special assemblies
- Special blood donation campaigns as coordinated with the Department of Health, the Philippine Blood Center, and the Philippine Red Cross
- Special recognition to public officers and private stakeholders who are in direct involvement with the saving and supporting of victims, survivors, and their families
- Put up memorials and tributes at strategic public places to commemorate the lives of the victims and promote the adherence to road safety regulations;


WHEREAS, the recorded high cases of road incidents in the country make it all the more important to observe the declaration: NOW, THEREFORE be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of Manila to commemorate as it is hereby commemorates the "National Day of Remembrance for Road Crash Victims, Survivors, and their Families", annually observed every third Sunday of November and encouraging strict adherence to road safety and traffic rules within the City of Manila; and be it FURTHER

RESOLVED, that the Manila Traffic and Parking Bureau (MTPB) strictly enforce national and local road safety and traffic regulations within the jurisdiction of the City of Manila; and be it FINALLY

RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished to the Manila Public Information Office for posting on their social media pages.
