AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 2 FOR THE VARIOUS PRIORITY PROJECTS OF THE CITY OF MANILA IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY MILLION (PHP150,000,000.00) AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991 provides that "every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare."

It further provides that "within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants.

Further, Section 17(a) of the LGC mandates "local government units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them. They shall also discharge the functions and responsibilities of national agencies and offices devolved to them pursuant to this Code.

Local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities enumerated herein."

In line with the promotion of the general welfare and safety of the residents of Manila through the installation of streetlights in major streets and thoroughfares, there is a need to enact a Supplemental Budget for FY 2024 to fund the implementation of the subject priority projects of the Manila City Government for the benefit of its residents pursuant to Sections 16 and 17 of the LGC.

To fund priority projects of the city, a supplemental budget may be enacted "when supported by funds actually available as certified by the local treasurer or by new revenue sources" (Section 321 of R.A. No. 7160) to ensure the implementation of the said priority projects for the general welfare of the residents of the City of Manila.

Pursuant to the foregoing statutory provisions, the City Treasurer and the City Accountant has issued the Certificate of Availability of Funds as supporting document to the promulgation of this Supplemental Budget.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, in session assembled, *THAT*:

SECTION 1. Appropriations. – The FY 2024 Supplemental Budget of the City of Manila in the total amount of One Hundred Fifty Million Pesos (P150,000,000.00) is hereby appropriated to fund the following priority projects of the City of Manila, to wit:






