AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO.1 IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION NINE HUNDRED FORTY-SIX THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED NINE PESOS (PHP2,946,909.00) UNDER MAINTENANCE AND OTHER OPERATING EXPENSES ACCOUNT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENGINEERING AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE FY 2025 ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991" provides that "every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare."

Further, Section 17 of the LGC mandates "local government units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them. They shall also discharge the functions and responsibilities of national agencies and offices devolved to them pursuant to this Code. Local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities enumerated herein."

To fund urgent expenditures of the city, a supplemental budget may be enacted "when supported by funds actually available as certified by the local treasurer or by new revenue sources" (Section 321 of R.A. No. 7160) to ensure the payment of expenditures which redound the promotion of the general welfare of the residents of the City of Manila.

In line with the promotion of the general welfare of the residents of the City of Manila, the settlement of the payables for the water consumption of the various Departments/Offices of the City which includes various health centers, hospital buildings (Ospital ng Tondo and Justice Jose Abad Santos General Hospital), housing facilities (Tondominium 1 and 2) and other facilities managed by the Public Recreations Bureau is necessary to ensure the provision of quality services to the residents. In this regard, additional funding has been requested by the Department of Engineering and Public Works (DEPW).

Pursuant to the foregoing statutory provisions, the City Treasurer and the City Accountant has issued the Certificate of Availability of Funds as supporting document to the promulgation of this Supplemental Budget.

The City Council likewise approved Resolution No.3, Series of 2025 of the Executive Committee of the City Development Council, entitled: "A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AMENDMENT OF THE ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM AND ISSUANCE OF A SUPPLEMENTAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM FOR FY 2025 FOR THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY OF MANILA UNDER THE MAINTENANCE AND OTHER OPERATING EXPENSES ACCOUNT".

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, in session assembled, *THAT*:

SECTION 1. Appropriations. – The FY 2025 Supplemental Budget of the City of Manila in the total amount of Two Million Nine Hundred Forty-Six Thousand Nine Hundred Nine Pesos (P2,946,909.00) is hereby appropriated to fund the urgent expenditures of the City of Manila, to wit:


