WHEREAS, on October 28, 2025, the City Council of Manila was in receipt of a 1st Indorsement letter from Dr. Grace H. Padilla, MD, MHA, FPPS, OIC – Manila Health Department (MHD), with attachment of a duly executed Contract of Affiliation it entered into that needs the ratification of this Sanggunian;

WHEREAS, the said Contract of Affiliation stipulates among others, that the Medical Technology students of National University, Incorporated, shall be provided with the necessary learning experience by utilizing available resources, materials and equipment of the Sta. Ana Hospital;
