RESOLUTION COMMEMORATING THE 150TH BIRTH ANNIVERSARY OF GREGORIA DE JESUS, THE "LAKAMBINI OF THE KATIPUNAN" AND HONORING HER ENDURING LEGACY AS A SYMBOL OF COURAGE, INTEGRITY AND WOMEN'S EMPOWERMENT

WHEREAS, Gregoria de Jesus was born on May 09, 1875, the wife of Andres Bonifacio, founder of the "Kataas-taasan, Kagalang-galangang Katipunan ng mga Anak ng Bayan (KKK)", and is revered in Philippine history as the "Lakambini ng Katipunan"

WHEREAS, Gregoria de Jesús played a major role in the Philippine Revolution, entrusted with the custody of the records and sacred seal of the "KKK" and a steadfast participant in the struggle for independence against colonial rule;

WHEREAS, the year 2025 marks the 150th birth anniversary of Gregoria de Jesús, one of three (3) heroes selected by the National Historical Commission of the Philippines for national commemoration;

WHEREAS, the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) and the Film Development Council of the Philippines (FDCP) have jointly supported initiatives celebrating Lakambini's life and legacy, including the production by Pelikulove of the film "Lakambini: Gregoria de Jesus", a creative and historical work that aims to reclaim the legacy of Gregoria de Jesus and restore the true meaning of "Lakambini";

WHEREAS, as the nation's capital and historic birthplace of countless milestones in the Philippine Revolution, the City of Manila recognizes the moral and civic duty to honor heroes who have shaped our national identity, particularly women whose sacrifices have often gone underrepresented in historical narratives: NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of Manila to commemorate, as it hereby commemorates the 150th Birth Anniversary of Gregoria de Jesus, the "Lakambini of the Katipunan" and honoring her enduring legacy as a symbol of courage, integrity and women's empowerment; and be it FURTHER

RESOLVED, that the City Government of Manila, through the Office of the Mayor and the Office of the Vice-Mayor, be encouraged to support cultural and educational initiatives that promote public awareness of "Lakambini's" life and values, including the community or educational screenings of the film "Lakambini: Gregoria de Jesus"; and be it FINALLY

RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW), the Film Development Council of the Philippines (FDCP) and Pelikulove.
