**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND MAINTAINING THE DANGWA FLOWER PARK**

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The Local Government Code empowers the cities to enact ordinances for the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants. Specifically, cities are authorized to approve ordinances which ensure the efficient and effective delivery of the basic services and facilities including public parks, markets other similar facilities.

The City of Manila is one with the national policy to establish and maintain public parks and green spaces and is in full support of the development of urban parks.

Dangwa Flower Market also known as Dangwa and Flower Market of Manila, fresh flower market located in Sampaloc, Manila, with flower shops centered along the streets of Dos Castillas, Laon-Laan, Dimasalang, and even extending to Lacson Avenue and Maria Clara Street, has served not only as a main source of fresh flowers, but also stood as a landmark and an important part of the cultural heritage of the City of Manila.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, in session assembled, *THAT*:

**SECTION. 1. Title.** - This ordinance shall also be known as the "Dangwa Flower Park Ordinance".

**SEC. 2. Declaration of Plan.** - It is the policy of the City of Manila enhance the quality of life of its residents and enhancing the ecological environment of the city and preserving its cultural heritage by establishing and maintaining public parks and similar facilities.

**SEC. 2. Creation of Dangwa Flower Park.** - The entire area covered by the flower shops in the Dangwa Flower Market located in Sampaloc, Manila, along the streets of Dos Castillas, Laong-Laan, Dimasalang, Lacson Avenue and Maria Clara Street, is hereby be known as "Dangwa Flower Park".

**SEC. 3. Management Plan.** - After consultation with various stakeholders, including the resident and merchants in the area involve, the City of Manila shall formulate a management Plan for the formulation, adoption, and implementation of sustainable management techniques.

**SEC. 4. Separability Clause.** - If, for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in force and effect.

**SEC. 5. Repealing Clause.** - All other ordinances, and other issuances, or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinances are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SEC. 3. Effectivity Clause.** - This Ordinance shall take effect after fifteen (15) days following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Manila immediately upon its approval.

This Ordinance was enacted by the City Council of Manila on November 20, 2025.


