ORDINANCE NO. 9152

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING EVERY BARANGAY TO INSTALL YEARLY AT LEAST TEN (10) CLOSED CIRCUIT TELEVISION (CCTV) DEVICE, WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF MANILA OR OTHERWISE TO BE KNOWN AS "THE BARANGAY CCTV ORDINANCE OF 2025"

EXPLANATORY NOTE

One of the inherent powers of the state aside from eminent domain and taxation, is Police Power, to which it sanctions that state, to enact certain laws that may restrict the rights of the citizenry on the goal of protecting the life and liberty of the general populace.

As provided for by the 1987 Philippine Constitution specifically under Article II, Section 5 thereof to wit; The maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by the people of the blessings of democracy.

Recent respectable surveys and studies conducted suggest the influx and rise of numerous criminal activities in the City of Manila. Thus, their immediate resolution and prevention is of Primordial Concern.

Data and information's gathered from different Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) devices have played a vital role in resolving illegal activities vis-à-vis heinous crime incidents in numerous places in the Philippines.

The commendable action of our City Mayor Honorable Francisco "Isko Moreno" Domagoso in the surrender and capture of the so-called "TNVS MURDER Culprits" was catapulted by recent CCTV Videos posted in different social-media platforms.

The shortage of law enforcement personnel can be augmented by the installation of CCTV devices around the City of Manila's jurisdiction.

The City Government of Manila as a legal unit to which the National Government devolves its powers and authority have the legal and moral responsibility in the prevention and solution of any lawless endeavor inside its jurisdiction.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Manila, in session assembled, *THAT*:

SECTION 1. Title. – This Ordinance shall be called as “The Barangay CCTV Ordinance of 2025 for the City of Manila”.

SEC. 2. Coverage. – This Ordinance shall cover and apply to every Barangay unit within the City Jurisdiction of Manila.

SEC. 3. Mandate. – As the title of this Ordinance in itself provides, it shall be mandatory for every barangay unit within the City of Manila to annually install and maintain at least ten (10) Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) device or camera within their territorial jurisdiction.

- a) The CCTV apparatus that would be installed must be capable of producing clear and recognizable images during nighttime and daytime conditions.
- b) Annual installation of CCTV gadgets shall only cease, until the entire Barangay Area of Jurisdiction is declared by the Manila Police District (MPD) through its respective Police Station Commanders that has authority over the Barangay concerned, to be equipped with the sufficient number of CCTV Device that can ensure the safety of its constituency.

SEC. 4. Enactment. – The concerned Barangay Units shall:

- A. Determine the most strategical location to which the CCTV recording device shall be installed within their territorial jurisdiction.
- B. They shall maintain and ensure the efficacy and continuous operation of the CCTV devices installed.
- C. The operation and maintenance of the CCTV Devices shall be under the authority and responsibility of the Barangay Chairman in coordination with the respective head (kagawad) who chairs the Committee on Peace and Order and Safety at the said Barangay Jurisdiction.
- D. They shall coordinate with the local Philippine National Police (PNP) Office concerned of the installation and location of the said CCTV Device.
- E. In cases where one or any of the CCTV device is defective it shall be their obligation to inform within twenty-four (24) hours the aforementioned local police where and what specific device is defective.
- F. The defective and inoperative device shall be immediately be repaired or replaced within twenty-four (24) hours from the time of its report with the local police office mentioned above.

SEC. 5. Source of Funding. – The Barangay in utilization of its respective fund shall be the primary source for the implementation of this Ordinance, however, the local government, shall augment funding for this Ordinance in cases where the concerned barangay units certify the scarcity of funds.

SEC. 6. Penalties. – Failure to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance shall subject the concerned Barangay Chairman and the Kagawad who chairs the Committee on Peace and Order of the Barangay concerned with:

First Offense	– Thirty (30) days suspension without pay and a fine of Two Thousand Pesos (PhP2,000.00)

Second Offense	–	Sixty (60) days suspension without pay and a fine of Three Thousand Pesos (PhP3,000.00)
Third and Succeeding Offense	–	Ninety (90) days suspension without pay and a fine of Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00)

SEC. 7. Data Privacy and Access. – The data collected by reason of this Ordinance, shall be used solely for public safety and law enforcement purpose, in accordance with existing laws, regarding data privacy, rules of evidence and other pertinent laws.

SEC. 8. Separability Clause. – If any provision of this Ordinance is declared null and void, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SEC. 9. Implementing Rules and Procedure. – The Manila Barangay Bureau (MBB), shall draft the Implanting Rules and Regulations (IRR) for this Ordinance within ninety (90) days from its effectivity, The MBB shall encourage the Manila Police District (MPD) to participate in the creation of the IRR to ensure the strategic areas in the City of Manila shall be covered by the CCTVs.

SEC. 10. Implementing Agency. – The Manila Barangay Bureau (MBB) shall be tasked with the implementation of the Ordinance as well as the monitoring of the compliance thereto.

SEC. 11. Amendments. – This Ordinance upon its effective shall amend other ordinance that might be repugnant to its contents, however, this Ordinance shall not in any way amend or repeal any provision of the National Law that has the same subject.

SEC. 12. Effectivity Clause. – This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its publication in a local newspaper or after its compliance with the publication requirements provided for by law.

This Ordinance was enacted by the City Council of Manila on November 27, 2025.
