WHEREAS, in a letter dated May 18, 2026, the Secretary to the Mayor, Manuel M. Zarcal, requested for the adoption of a resolution granting authority to the Local Chief Executive to enter into a Contract of Affiliation with the Jose R. Reyes Memorial Medical Center;

WHEREAS, the letter-request, together with the proposed Contract of Affiliation was referred to the City Council for appropriate action;

WHEREAS, Section 22(c) of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", empowers the Local Chief Executive to enter into contracts on behalf of the local government unit upon prior authorization by the Sanggunian concerned: NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of Manila to grant, as it hereby grants the Honorable City Mayor Francisco "Isko Moreno" Domagoso, authority to enter into a Contract of Affiliation with the Jose R. Reyes Memorial Medical Center for the training of its Post Graduate Interns in the field of Community Medicine to be provided with related learning and exposure at the Manila Health Department (MHD); and be it FURTHER

RESOLVED, that a copy of the Contract of Affiliation be made an integral part of this Resolution.

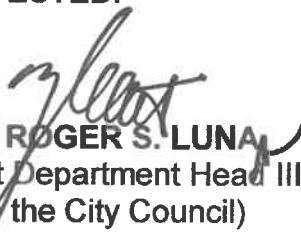
